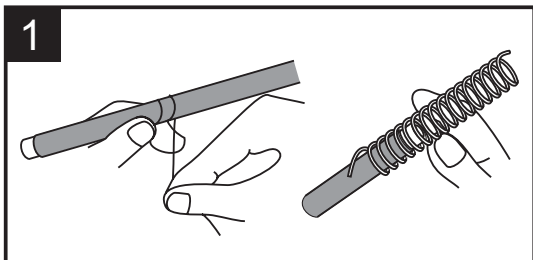
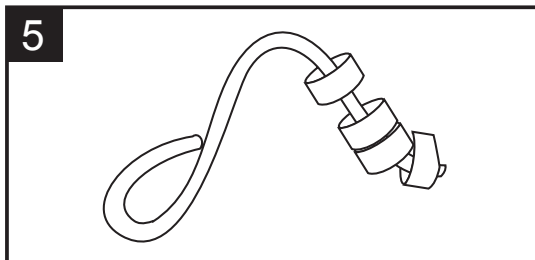


MAKE YOUR OWN SPIRAL SNAKE

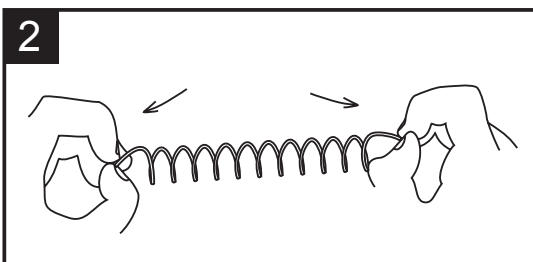
YOU'LL NEED
1 X OLD PIECE OF WIRE (45CM)
2 - 4 X USED DRINKING STRAWS
(DIFFERENT COLOURS)
1 X PEN OR PENCIL
1 X SCISSORS



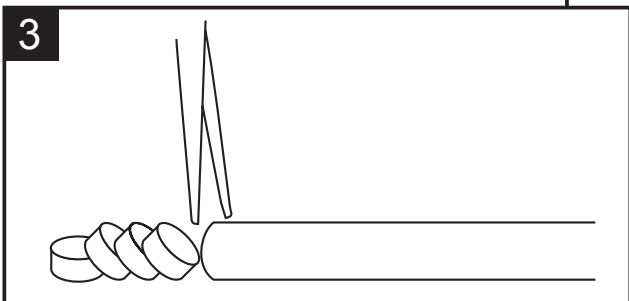
Make a spring by winding the wire around the pencil.



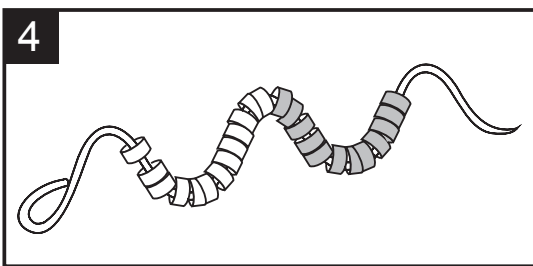
Bend each end back to stop the straw pieces falling off.



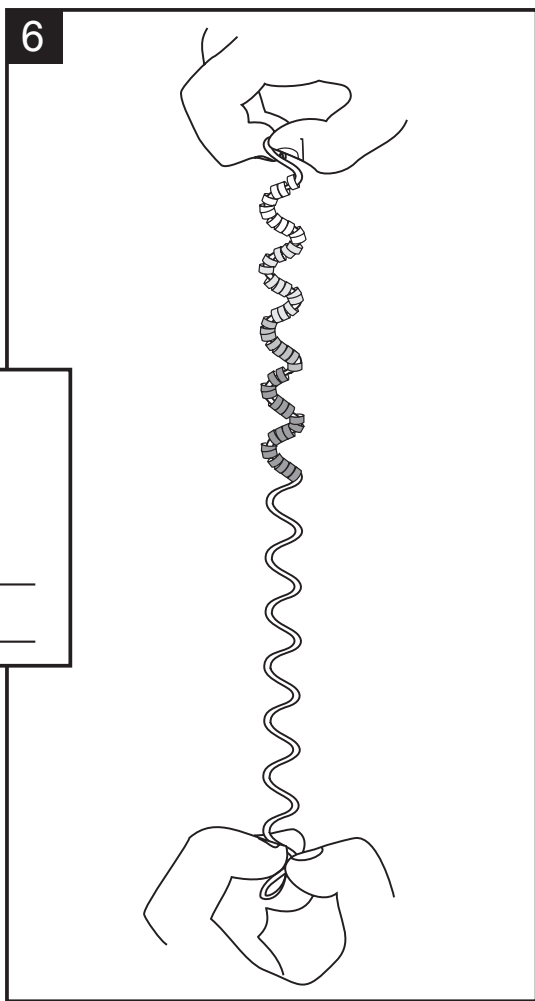
Slip the wire off the spring and pull each end to make a stretched spiral.



Cut straws into 16 x 0.5cm pieces.



Feed straw pieces onto wire, mixing up the colours.



Hold the wire vertically and watch the straw pieces slide down like a slithery snake. Flip to play again.
